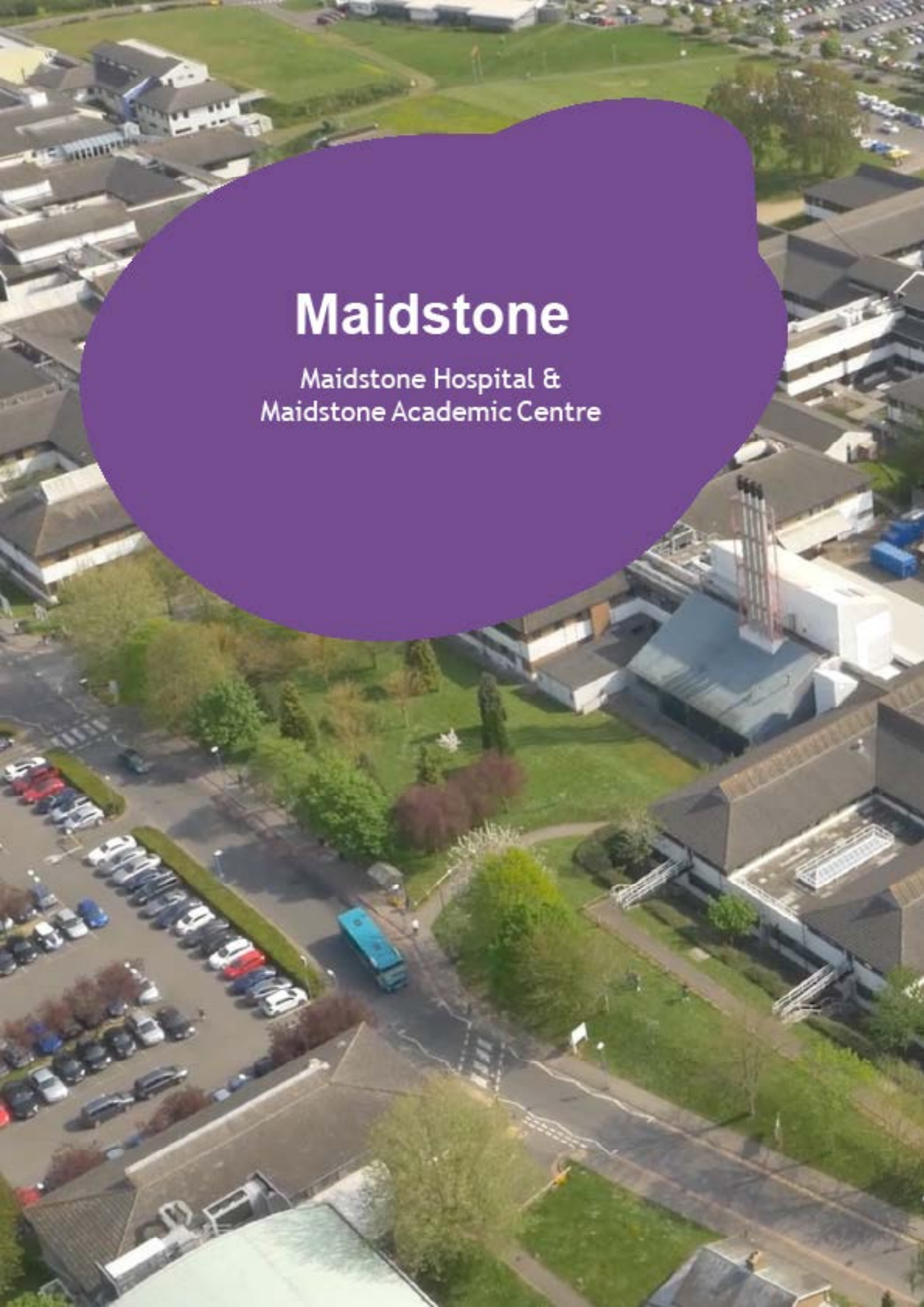

- Leave the M20 at junction 5 to join the A20 towards Maidstone.
- Turn right at the 2nd roundabout to join the A20 towards Sevenoaks and take the next left onto the B2246, Hermitage Lane.
- Maidstone Hospital is on the left-hand side.

By Train

If you are coming to Maidstone Hospital by train, the nearest station is Barming (0.88 miles) and Maidstone East (2.46miles). If you would like assistance in planning your journey, you may wish to use the <http://www.nationrail.co.uk>. There is limited bus service on Hermitage Lane and as an alternative to walking you can always arrange a taxi prior to arriving at the station on the numbers below.

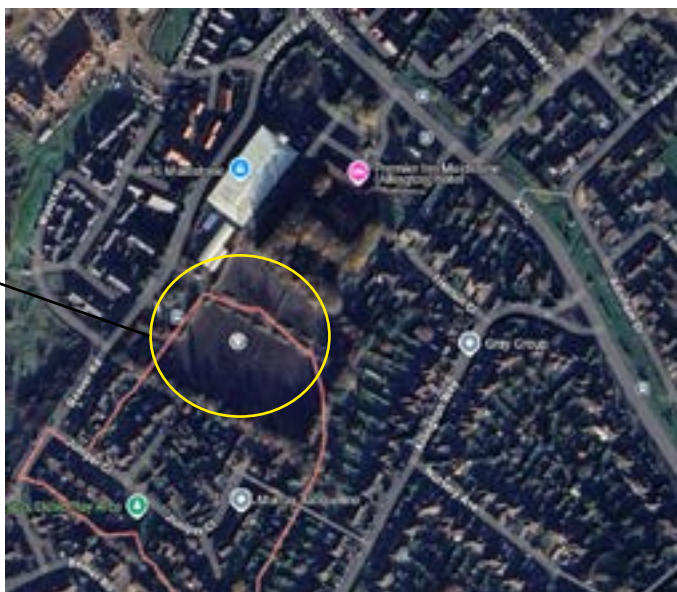

A Park and Ride service offers a free alternative to parking on site at Maidstone hospital.

- Park at one of our free car parks. The car park for Maidstone is on London Road, ME16 0LP.
- Jump on the bus to the hospital. Buses run every half an hour 6.40am - 9pm (approx.) depending on the site and take around 10 minutes (depending on traffic).
- Get the bus back to your car.

Park and Ride Location -

The post code for the park and ride site is ME16 0XP. This post code includes some residential streets, so drivers using sat nav should look out for the large car park behind the DFS store, just off Beaver Road.

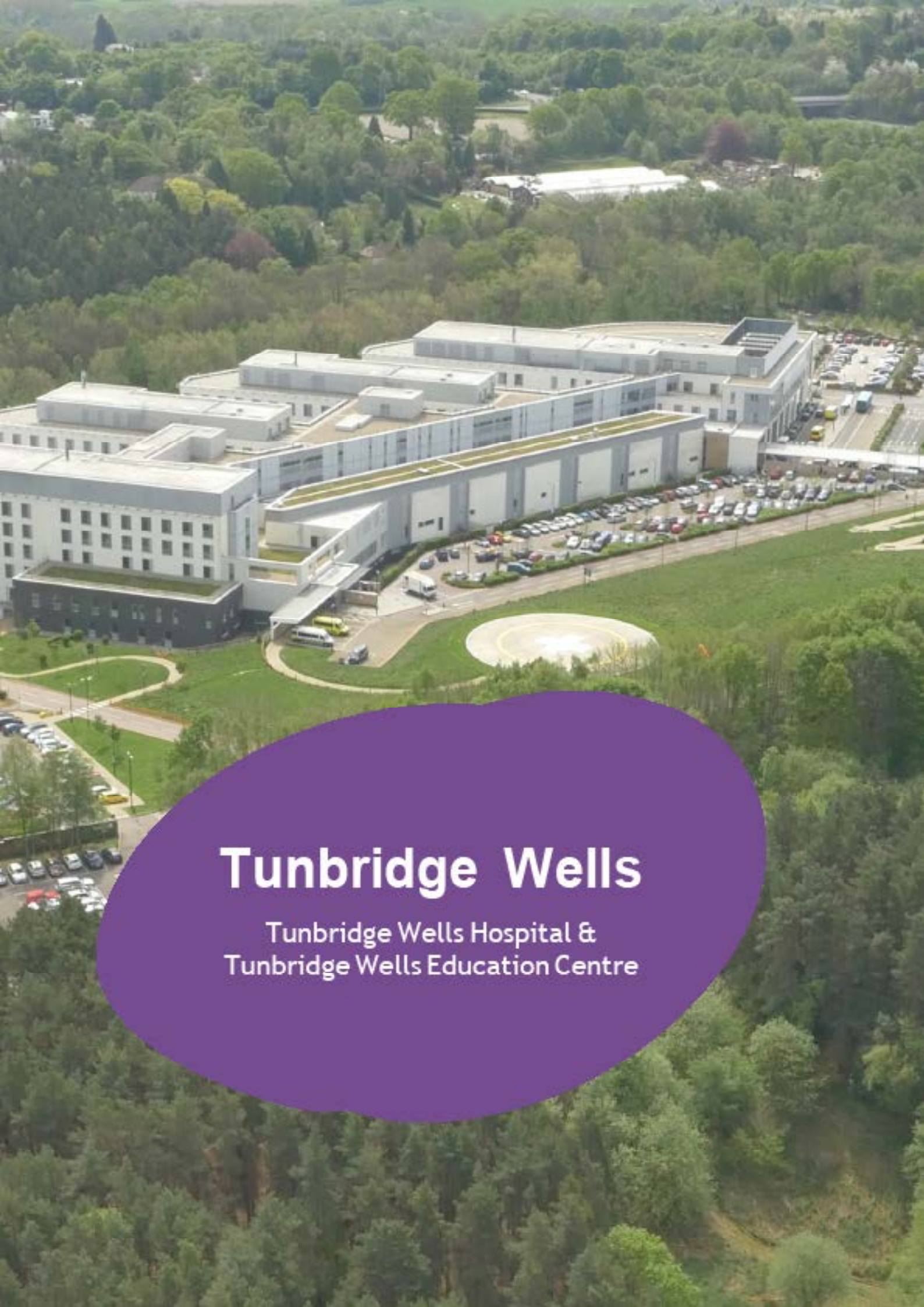
Hospital Map

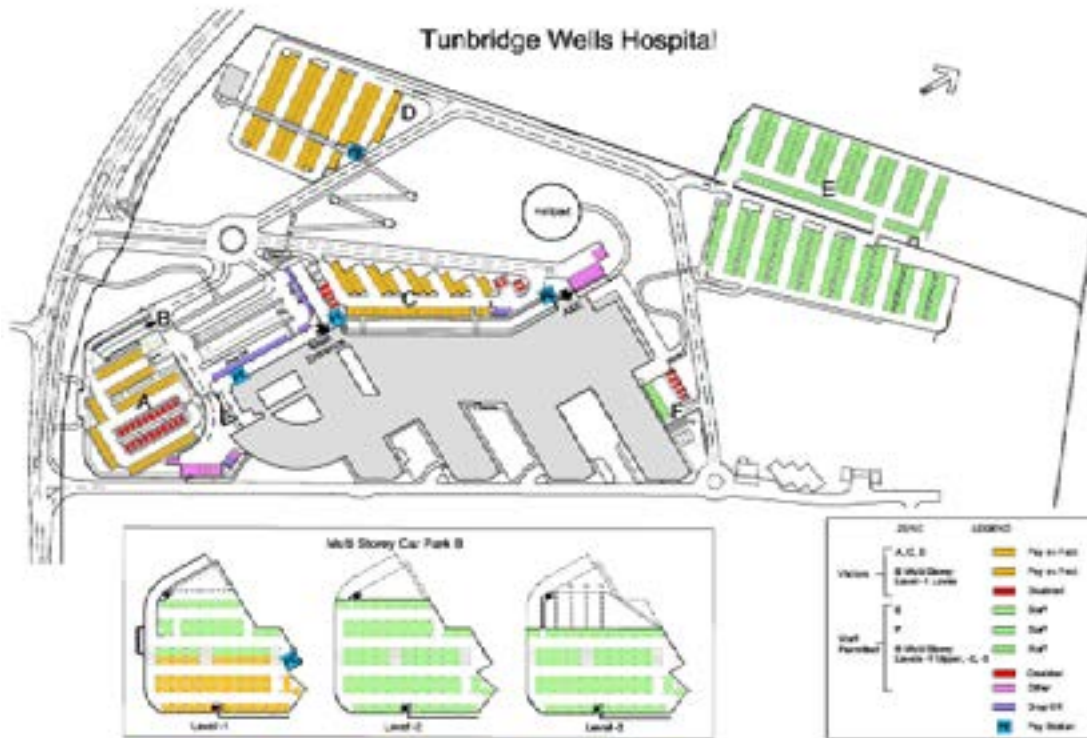

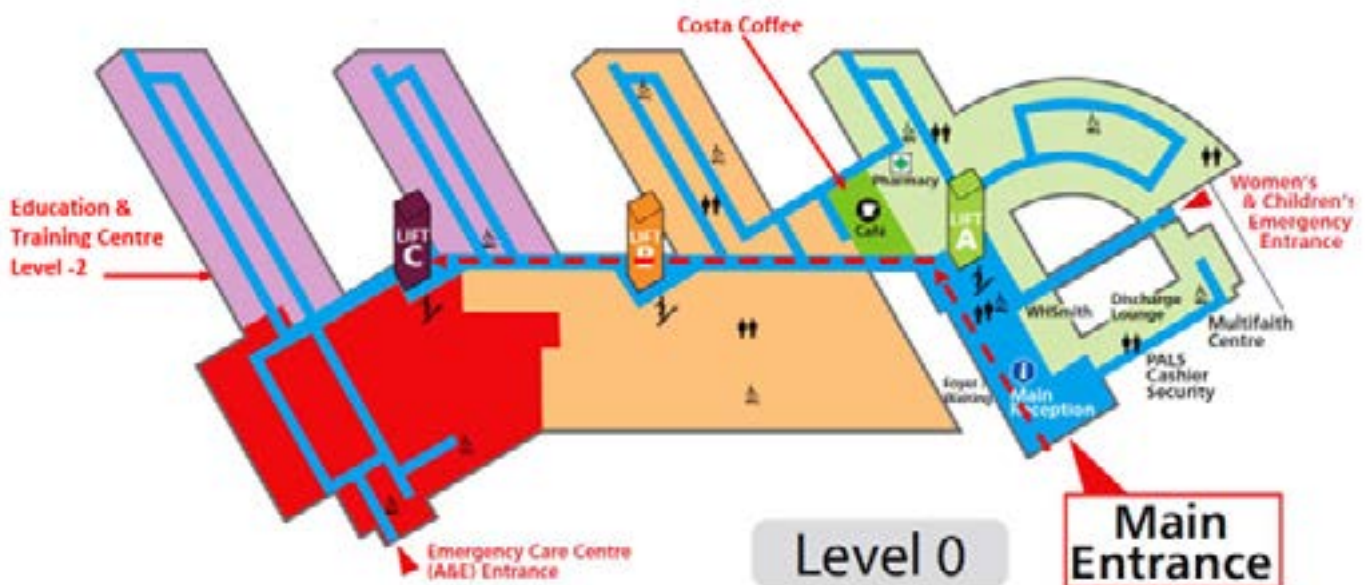

Finding the Tunbridge Wells Education Centre

If you enter through the Main Entrance on Level 0, walk through the Main Reception area and turn left along the corridor past Costa Coffee. Continue along this corridor towards Lifts and Stairs C in the Purple Zone. If you enter through Car Park B on Level -1, walk along the corridor past Café @ Minus One following the signs to Lifts and Stairs C in the Purple Zone. Take the lift or stairs down to Level -2. Turn left when you enter the corridor and the Education & Training Centre is immediately on your right.



By Car

- From the M25:
- Take the A21 south for 12.5 miles. At the roundabout take the 1st exit onto Tonbridge Road and proceed along until reaching the traffic light junction outside the Hospital.
- Turn left into the main Hospital entrance where visitor and staff parking are both available.

If you choose to park in one of the Staff Car Parks, a £2 reduced daily fee is payable via a tablet in the Main Reception.

By Train

- Jump on the bus to the hospital. Buses run every half an hour 6.40am - 9pm (approx.) and take 10 minutes (depending on traffic).
- Get the bus back to your car.

Park and Ride location -

The post code for the park and ride site is TN2 3UW.

When using the Tunbridge Wells Hospital park and ride service from Knights Park, you will need to register your number plate at the tablet in main reception at the hospital on arrival.
